Rules:

***Burnouts**- Burn outs are allowed. Traction Compound will be allowed (bring your own). Water will be applied by Crossroads staff if enough volunteer help and water is available is available. Across the line burnouts are allowed.

***Batteries**- Must be securely mounted to vehicle. Factory hold-downs are acceptable.

***Fluid leaks**- Vehicle must be free of fluid leaks to prevent compromising the track surface. Vehicles that have visible fluids leaks will be barred from competition until the leak has been repaired.

***Tires**- Must be in good condition and free from cracking, cuts, or bulges. All lug studs must have lug nuts tightened. Slicks will be permitted. It is highly recommended that vehicles running slicks have a drive line loop installed.

***Seatbelts**- All vehicles are required to have seatbelts. Drivers and passengers are required to wear seatbelts at all times during their run.

***Driver Requirements**- Drivers must be at least age sixteen and have a current valid driver's license.

***Car Control**- If a vehicle starts to get out of control, the driver must abort the run. Drivers appearing to take unreasonable risks may be barred from further competition.

***Motorcycles, Snowmobiles**- Will not be allowed at this time.

***Pickups**- everything must be removed from the bed of the pickup, including toolboxes unless permanently mounted. Bed must be swept completely clean of any debris, and all mud must be cleaned from underneath. If mud or debris falls from vehicle onto the track, vehicle could be barred from competition until it meets the requirement.

***Passenger**- All participants (driver, crew members, etc.) shall act in a sportsmanlike manner at all times. Anyone acting in an abusive or threatening manner towards other racers, crew, or volunteer staff will be asked to leave.

***Return speed, Staging Lanes, Pits**- The maximum speed limit in the return lane is 40 mph. In the pits or staging lanes, the speed limit is 5 mph. No burnouts, test launches, or other contests of speed will be tolerated in these areas.

***NO ALCOHOL**- ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED INSIDE THE PIT AREA. Any participant suspected of consuming alcohol will be banned from competition.

Racing is dangerous and is done at your own risk. No insurance is provided for damage to vehicles or for bodily injury while participating. Personal auto insurance generally excludes speed contest from coverage, so all liability for damage, physical injury, or other claims arising from such are assumed solely by the vehicle driver/owner. By signing this form, driver agrees to assume liability for them selves and their crew and agrees to abide by all facility rules.
