Green Mountain:

- 1. Water Well \$50,000
 - a. Drilling a water well would give running water into the campground.
- 2. Quality solar Camera for usage \$7000
 - a. A camera would be used to be able to track the usage of the campground and be able to see any vandalism.

Youth Camp:

- 1. Solar system for the Camp \$131,050
 - a. This would solve a lot of the powerline problems from the warming hut up to the Youth Camp. We could also generate electricity and sell back to the Power Company.
- 2. Sewer plant upgrades \$25,000

- 3. Kitchen upgrade \$20,000
 - a. The kitchen needs upgrades. The walk-in cooler is in need of upgrades along with other items
- 4. Filter system at spring to meet EPA standards \$100,000
 - a. The EPA is going to inspect the spring that feeds water to the camp. If they find it needs a filtering system, the camp will be forced to install one at the Spring.
- 5. Quality solar Camera for usage \$7000
 - a. A camera would be used to be able to track the usage of the camp and be able to record any vandalism.
- 6. Cell personal tower booster \$20,000

Heritage Trail:

- 1. 17 bridges decking \$200,000
 - a. All the bridges need new decking.
- 2. Black Bridge, Poison Creek and Muskrat Creek maintenance \$200.000
 - a. These are the larger bridges that need maintenance to keep from causing a major bridge repair.
- 3. Raising the banks at the ponds \$27,000
 - a. Due to high water the banks at the ponds have been washed away.
- 4. Bollards at entrances to the trail 14 bollards \$16,000
 - a. These would be installed to detour large vehicles from accessing the trail
- 5. Equipment for maintaining trail
 - a. Need trail groomer to maintain the trail.
- 6. Quality solar camera for usage \$7000
 - a. A camera would be used to be able to track the usage of the trail and be able to record any vandalism.

Other projects:

- 1. Would like to reinstate grant money for groups
 - a. We have had several groups contact the Rec Board inquiring if the grants will be reinstated.
